

II Timothy 2:15 *What Difference Does Rightly Dividing Make to My Worship*

Acts 18:12,13: "...*the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul...Saying, This fellow persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law*"

Acts 24:14: "...after the way which they call *heresy*, so *worship* I the God of my fathers, *believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets*"

Genesis 22:5: "Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; *and I and the lad will go yonder and worship*, and come again to you"

Romans 12:1: "...present your bodies *a living sacrifice*, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service"

Deuteronomy 26:10: "...I have brought the firstfruits of the land...*and worship before the Lord*"

II Samuel 12:20: "David arose from the earth...and came into the house of the Lord, *and worshipped*"

Job 1:20,21: "Job arose...and fell down upon the ground, *and worshipped*, And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away; *blessed be the name of the Lord*"

Matthew 2:2,11: "Where is He that is born King of the Jews? *for we...are come to worship Him...And when they were come...they saw the young child...and worshipped Him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts; gold, and frankincense and myrrh*"

Matthew 15:9: "...in vain they do *worship Me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men*"

Deuteronomy 11:26-28: "Behold, *I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the Lord...And a curse, if ye will not obey...*"

Romans 6:15: "...*we are not under the law, but under grace...*"

Romans 13:8-10: "...love one another: for he that loveth another *hath fulfilled the law*. For this, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbor, *therefore love is the fulfilling of the law*"

II Corinthians 5:14,15: "the love of Christ constraineth us, because...He died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, *but unto Him which died for them, and rose again*"

Colossians 2:21: "Touch not; taste not; handle not"

Colossians 2:20-22: "...why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, (Touch not; taste not; handle not...) *after the commandments and doctrines of men?*"

Leviticus 20:24,25: “I am the LORD your God, which have separated you from other people. Ye shall *therefore* put difference between clean beasts and unclean”

I Corinthians 7:19: “Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, *but the keeping of the commandments of God*”

I Corinthians 14:37: “If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that *I* write unto you *are the commandments of the Lord*”

I Thessalonians 4:2: “For ye know what commandments *we gave you by the Lord Jesus*”

II Thessalonians 3:6: “Now *we command you*, brethren...”

II Thessalonians 3:12: “Now them that are such *we command*...”

Philippians 3:2,3: “Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the concision. For we are the circumcision, *which worship God in the spirit*...and have no confidence in the flesh”

Matthew 15:26: “It is not meet to take the children’s bread, *and to cast it to dogs*”

Colossians 2:10,11: “...ye are *complete in Him*...circumcised with the circumcision *made without hands*...by the circumcision of Christ”

Daniel 9:26: “After threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be *cut off*, but not for Himself...”

Isaiah 53:8: “...He was cut off *out of the land of the living*...”

Deuteronomy 10:16: “Circumcise therefore the foreskin *of your heart*, and be no more stiffnecked”

Romans 2:29: “He is a Jew, which is one *inwardly*...circumcision is that of the heart, *in the spirit*”

Deuteronomy 30:6: “*And the Lord thy God will circumcise thine heart*, and the heart of thy seed, *to love the Lord thy God with all thine heart*, and with all thy soul, *that thou mayest live*”

Matthew 3:9: “...think not to say within yourselves, *We have Abraham to our father*”

I Corinthians 5:7: “Christ *our passover* is sacrificed for us”

Isaiah 66:23,24: “it shall come to pass, that...all flesh come *to worship before Me*, saith the Lord. And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against Me: *for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched*; and they shall be an abhorring...”

Revelation 16:7: “Lord God Almighty, *true and righteous are Thy judgments*”
